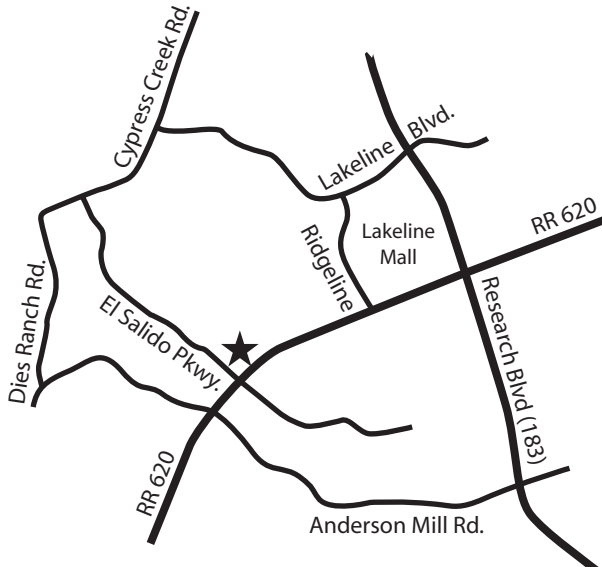

Bluebonnet 2009 Summer Day Camp Highlights

- **Waterplay** every day is offered on our own exciting water park or in our own swimming pool.
- **Field trips** will take us to interesting places and we'll have camp visitors, such as a magician, a story teller and Mad Science to spark children's imaginations.
- **Small groups** of children are divided by age and led by mature, experienced counselors.

Your child is safer in a facility regulated by TDFPS. Parents should ask who regulates their child's summer camp.
